

As one seeks the words in the dictionary one learns that Chaucer, Spenser and the Ballads were the wells from which he drew these rare words, and that his employment of them is only another phase of his love for the old far-off things. It is true that the language of Morris is not of any one (s. 70] stadium of English, but it is a poet s privilege to draw upon all history for his words as well as for his allusions, and the revivals in question are of worthy...
